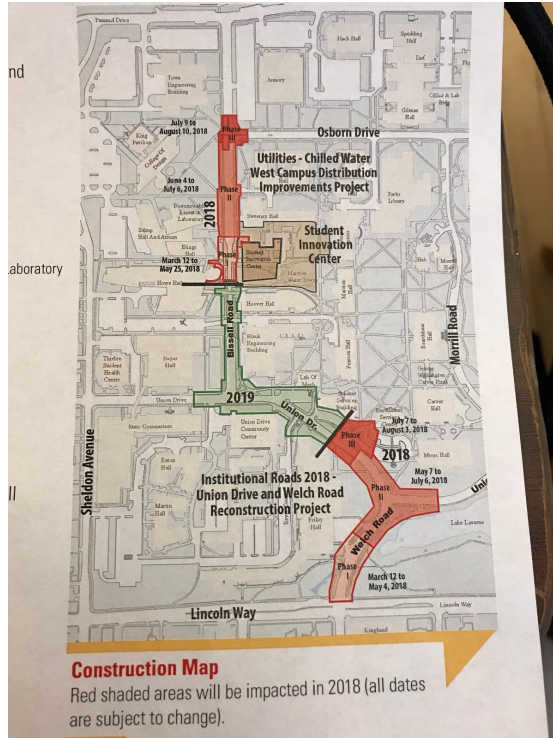

 - I am working on some outreach to discuss CyBowl and Billiards. I have coupons for you all. We currently have many different promotions. Union Drive/Welch Avenue Road Reconstruction and Bissell Road Utilities Improvements

Dates: Mid March - Mid August 2018 (all projected dates subject to change)

- » Bissell Road (intersection of Bissell Road and Osborn to Howe Hall)

Why: Improve pedestrian safety, reconstruct deteriorated road and improve campus character along Welch Avenue, Union Drive and Bissell Road. New chilled water along Bissell Road will allow for cooler buildings during warm seasons in the southwest area of campus.
